MAZIS-CHAMBERTIN

VINEYARD

Gevrey-Chambertin is a large town in the Côte de Nuits, with one of the largest vineyards of the Côte d'Or. Its wines are powerful and round, thanks to a good amount of clay marl in the limestone soil. Its AOC vineyards are planted on slopes, located between 240 and 280 m above sea level. It should also be noted that the village has nine Grands Crus over a total surface area of 85.50 ha, 8.79 of which are the Mazis-Chambertin Grand Cru.
